
Cover Story

INTERVIEW WITH AUTHOR MUKUL RANJAN



Mukul Ranjan is a director and screenwriter in Hindi film industry. His origins lie in Bihar's Madhubani district. He is a humanities graduate from Tilka Manjhi Bhagalpur University. Later he took his Master's degree in Journalism from Mumbai University. Journalism was not his calling as he considers himself primarily a raconteur. He started his career as a screen writer with a Hindi film. He has written and directed several movies, documentaries and TV shows. Singing, travelling and working towards sustainable living are his hobbies. COLD COCK is his debut novel.

Tell us the story behind the creation of "Cold Cock." What were the events that led to its creation?

I was trying to write a novel. I had several stories in mind for it. But I set it up inside a TV channel to make it more lively and found it to be a fresh setting for a novel. The glamour aspect of it, weird characters, the lingo, everything fell into place after it.

"Cold Cock" is developed in an abstract manner that reaches the readers in no time. Did you have any other ideas for its construction or chose the poetry format for writing in the first place?

I had other ideas definitely for building up the narrative. But after mulling for a long time on the technique I decided on this route to make it easily absorbent for my readers. Techniques, if applied wrongly, defeat the whole purpose, mostly. So, I kept it minimal and abstract.

"Cold Cock" strongly stimulates the readers to take an objective approach and understand life in that light. How approach? did you as a person develop this approach?

It happens with time. Nature finds a way to prepare you for your future life; first as parents in the house, second as teacher in the school and finally, third as a senior or boss at the work place. Then one sits back and tries to apply one's mind to the challenges his/her life throws ahead.

How would you describe your literary endeavours and all that went into your making as a writer before "Cold Cock" materialized?

I have been writing for newspapers, magazines and radio since my college days. I chose to be a screen writer in the Hindi film industry after training as a journalist. I also have my blog site where I write blogs regularly. So the next step was writing a novel. Cold Cock is a junction, metaphorically speaking, for my long journey as a writer!

As a title, "Cold Cock" carries associations that touch multiple dimensions. What is the story behind its creation?

I was waiting for this question. Lot of people have asked me why the title of my debut novel is Cold Cock. Please allow me to be immodest for once. The story of naming it Cold Cock is as interesting as the novel itself. After I finished writing it I had a title. And obviously, I was excited about it. But with time I started looking for a different title. So another title came to me. I was happy and thought I would stick to it. But again, I was itchy to get a nice title. Look, I seriously believe that if the title is apt half the job is done. A full year passed and there was no title. With time I forgot about both, my novel and its new title.

There are so many unique perspectives in your "Cold Cock." What is the most challenging thing about writing such complexity in a simpler version?

I call it 'detach the attachment'. Its a thin, challenging transparent line as an author. One needs to be attached to one's characters to figure out everything that they would do next. And at the same time, stay detached in order to remain objective and keep it simple. I believe that is how one gains the trust of one's readers and followers.

I wish you luck with your future ventures and hope to read more powerful and exciting books from your pen. Thank you for sparing your time.

Book Review: "You Can Become Rich"



What books did you read that talk about the importance of money, saving and investing?




In a friendly manner, if there was one situation to imagine during the Pandemic that you wanted to change with all the money you had, what is\was that?

Tell us something about your book – Love ka lover dose?




How easy/ difficult it was for you to publish your book? What message would you like to give to budding authors?

Title: The Souvenir Author: Baishali Sarkar

To this context, Baishali Sarkar's book "The Souvenir" is a collection of poetries stating the different aspects of her life experiences in the form of short poetries.

90's kids will definitely recollect the memories from the lines depicting the era of simplicity and Power-cuts. The author believes that every pages when turned over will throw a positive

gesture to one's imagination and cherish the memories effectively.
